

AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Merrill, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 36, Article II, Division II, Section 36-26(d)(4)(b) of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Merrill is amended as follows:

Sec. 36-26(d)(4)(b) Other Parking Violations

- (b) Any person, either the registered owner of or driver of a motor vehicle who causes or permits such vehicle to be unlawfully parked as set forth in section 36-89 shall be subject to a forfeiture of ~~\$150.00~~~~50.00~~ for each violation; in addition, the city may order such vehicle towed. The procedures and charges for towing shall be the same as provided in article VI of this chapter. In the event that forfeitures imposed under this subsection are not paid within five days of the date of the violation, the amount due shall increase to ~~\$300.00~~~~75.00~~.

Section 2. Severability. In the event any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance. It is the legislative intent of the Common Council that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal provision had not been included or any illegal application had not been made.

Section 3. Repeal and Effective Date. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

Subject: Non-Fire Department employees using workout equipment in new fire station

The new fire station has a workout room on the second floor that is equipped with a stair climber, stationary bike, elliptical machine, treadmill, universal weight machine and free weights. I have had inquiries from non-Fire Department city employees concerning the ability to utilize this equipment. I have spoken with the Fire Chief and he would not object to other city employees utilizing the equipment within specific parameters, such as limited hours, sign in when in the building, keep area clean, etc. Anyone not abiding by any set rules would no longer be allowed access to the equipment.

Since the city is in the process of establishing an Employee Wellness Program, allowing employees to use the exercise equipment should be a long-term health benefit for employees who elect to do so. It is my recommend that this usage be authorized within parameters established by the Fire Chief.




