I. Call to Order

Mayor Woellner called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

Roll call showed all Common Council members present with the exception of Alderman Norton, who was absent.

V. Public Comment Period

Mayor Woellner announced that public comment for this meeting would be held "open" until 4:30 P.M. on Friday, April 24th. People can submit comments to their alderperson, Mayor Woellner or City Administrator Johnson. There was no other public comment.

VI. Introduction of Common Council members

The Common Council members all introduced themselves.

VII. Roll Call for newly-elected Common Council

Roll call showed all Common Council members present.

VIII. Elections and Mayor's Appointments:

1. Elect President of the Common Council

Alderman Van Lieshout nominated Alderman Russell.

Alderman Sabatke nominated Alderman Hass, who then declined the nomination.

There were no other nominations.

On a voice vote, Alderman Russell was elected President of the Common Council.

2. Elect Alderperson member of the City Plan Commission

Alderman Osness nominated Alderman Hass.

There were no other nominations.

On a voice vote, Alderman Hass was elected to be the Alderperson member of the City Plan Commission.

3. Mayor's Appointments of Alderpersons to City sub-committees

Mayor Woellner announced one amendment to the appointments, as follows: Alderman Weix to the Health and Safety Committee, rather than Alderman Hass.

Motion (Osness/Van Lieshout) to approve the appointments, including the amendment requested by Mayor Woellner.

4. Consider 60-day extension for citizen members serving on City sub-committees

Motion (Hass/Van Lieshout) to approve the 60-day extension.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERRILL, WISCONSIN this 21st day of April, 2020, that the Merrill FotoNews of Merrill, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, shall be and is hereby designated, until further action, as the official newspaper for the City of Merrill.
